



RESOLUTION:

**CALL ON IMMEDIATE ABOLITION OF ROAMING CHARGES WITHIN
THE COMMON MARKET**

*Adopted at the YEPP Congress in Porto, Portugal
On the 16th of May 2015*

Recognising:

- That the Council of the European Union has postponed the abolition of roaming charges within the common market to the end of 2018, thereby challenging plans both of the European Parliament and the European Commission.

Acknowledging:

- That an end to roaming charges would financially relieve 500 million EU citizens and further strengthen the common market as well as the development of a European civil society;
- That the abolition of roaming charges would especially motivate young Europeans to cross their Member State borders and thus to grow together as a true European generation.

YEPP calls on:

- The European Union, especially the Council, to immediately abolish any roaming charges for EU citizens within the common market.
