



Resolution

Concerning the relation between EU and Moldova

Stating that:

- The recent completion of the EU-Moldova Action Plan in Republic of Moldova in 2008 resulted in a series of actions undertaken by the Moldovan Government for ensuring the legislative, institutional, economical and social reforms in Moldova in line with European standards.
- The efforts of the Moldovan Government and civil society resulted in the completion of the most of the agreement provisions, thus proving the pro-European aspiration of the Republic of Moldova.
- European Commission is editing a new juridical Agreement between Moldova and the European Union that is to be concluded and passed to the EU Council for adoption.

Recognizing:

- The efforts of the Republic of Moldova of sharing the same values with the European Union
- The importance of promoting good economic and political relations with this country, as an EU neighbour.

The Youth of the European People's Party calls the European Commission, the EU Council and other institutions involved in the dialogue with the Republic of Moldova:

- To continue encouraging the Republic of Moldova to follow its democratization process, by supporting the civic society and well-functioning market economy.

- To continue a positive evolution in the bilateral relations between Moldova and the EU that should result in a new cooperation agreement.
- For more active participation of the EU in the 5+2 format of negotiations of Transnistrian conflict.

The Youth of the European People's Party calls authorities of Moldova:

- To continue the process of consolidation of the independence of judicial power, including the reformation of status of prosecutor office, the consolidation of autonomy of local power, the assurance of rights of local communities for self-governance, the free media and the protection of human rights in the spirit of democracy and of the European standards and norms.

The Youth of the European People's Party underlines that:

- The free and fair upcoming parliamentary elections in Moldova in April 2009 are of high importance for all political parties for a positive future dialogue between EU and Moldova

The Youth of the European People's Party:

- Reiterates its support to the efforts undertaken by its member organization from Moldova – NG PPCD in the democratization and integration process of Moldova.
- Declares full solidarity, respect and total support to NG PPCD as a political youth organization, motivated to continue to strive for independence, democracy and successful society in Moldova
